## Kristianstad University

- Kristianstad University was founded in 1977
- Approximately 13,000 students and 500 employees
- A total of 40 programmes and 630 courses







### Food and Meal Science

An interdisciplinary research and education field at Kristianstad University with a vision to create a sustainable and healthy society.

A multidisciplinary field based on three scientific areas:

- Food Science
- Nutrition and Health
- Food Culture and Communication



#### Two different educations

 MSc in Subject Education, Teachers in home and consumer studies

 BSc in Food and Meal Science "Gastronomists"





#### BSc in Food and Meal Science

The program has been running since 2004.

Based on the three scientific fields complemented by:

Science, Craftsmanship and Creativity

Theory is turned into practice through laborative exercises and working life placements

- Educational kitchen
- Sensory laboratory,
  16 booths
- Small adjacent food quality laboratory





## What engages the students?

The bachelor theses typically deal with:

- Public meals (for children, elderly or at workplaces)
- Culture and communication of food and meals
- Product development
- Issues connected to food and health

### What becomes of the students?

Approximately 25 gastronomists graduate yearly

 Find work opportunities within industry, eg innovations and product development and within the public meal sector.



#### The future....

- Development of a Master´s degree programme for students interested in higher education
- Internationalization by courses taught in English
- Very open to Nordic and other research and education collaborations
