# Copenhagen Foodscapes – exploring alternative foodscenes

Alternativeness and creativity seems to be driving the urban food revolution. This excursion that uses the well-known Copenhagen CityBike, will take you round some of the hot spots of the bustling alternative CPH foodscene where alternative sketches for sustainable urban foodtures are developed and tested.

### Program:

- Get on the bike and pass by one of CPH's busy food streets at Værnedamsvej.
- 1<sup>st</sup> stop: see and feel how young people at school acquire food, growing and gardening skills in Copenhagen school gardens.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> stop: meet young aquaponics entrepreneur Lasse Carlsen and his colleagues that developed the Green & Blue Aquaponics food place at Valhallgade – part of CPH's latin quarter.
- Lunch: Before biking back to campus we will enjoy a food truck kind of lunch in the facility.
